Date 18th January 2015

Travel: Just East of Ashurst Nr. Lyndhurst, on the A35.

Car Park: Ashurst Camp Site SU331100

The event centre is at Ashurst Camp Site, Please share transport where possible.

Grid ref SU331100, Postcode SO40 7AD.

Car Parking Fee £1 per car.

Map and terrain: 1:10,000 A3 Map 5m contours.

The terrain is typical New Forest, mainly open woodland and some open heath and forest lawns. Very runnable and fast!

There is a 1.8K walk to the Start & back from the Finish. Please take care when crossing the campsite entry road and also at the manned road crossing on the A35.

There will be a clothing dump very close to the Start and Finish. Bring your own bag.

Courses:

White 1.6K 20m.

Yellow 2.0K 20m.

Orange 3.5K 30m.

Light Green 3.4K 40m.

Short Green 4.3K 40m.

Green 5.8K 60m.

Blue 8.0K 90m.

Brown 9.3K 95m.

NOTE: White & Yellow Courses will have Smiley Faces to help lead participants between certain controls.

Courses Close: 14:15

Entry on the Day only.

Fees: Adult BOF Members £8 Adult non BOF £10 Juniors £4

The EMIT system. Hire cards will be available - free for juniors, £1.50 for adults.
