Southampton Orienteering Club Level D event at

Lucas Castle and Highland Water Final Details

Location: Car parking is opposite the Canadian War Memorial at GR SU239091. Nearest postcode SO43

7GQ. Signposted from Janesmoor Pond at GR SU246130.

Facilities: Red Baron catering, toilets.

Entries: Entry on the day only. Adults £7, members £5, juniors £3. EMIT hire £1.50.

Map: Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours, updated Summer 2014. Courses and control descriptions will

be over printed on waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions will be available in the start

lanes.

Timing system: EMIT, punching start.

Courses: Blue 7.2km, 210m climb, 16 controls Red 5.0km, 160m climb, 11 controls

Green 5.0km, 115m climb, 12 controls Orange 3.3km, 85m climb, 10 controls Lt Green 4.2km, 90m climb, 10 controls Yellow 2.6km, 40m climb, 10 controls

Terrain: Typical New Forest terrain of open heathland and runnable woodland. The deciduous and

coniferous woodland areas are linked by a network of forest tracks and rides. After heavy

rainfall some of the rides are likely to become muddy and therefore unsuitable for

pushchairs. The area to the NE of map (visited by Blue course) offers good contour detail. The area is frequented by ponies, deer and livestock and the usual precautions to avoid

infection apply. Full leg cover is compulsory, full arm cover is recommended.

Start: The start is located about 300m from registration across a minor road.

Times: Registration: 10:15 - 14:00

Starts: 10:30 - 14:30

Courses close: 16:00

Clothing: Full leg cover is mandatory. Please be aware of the risk of ticks and Lymes disease.

Whistles: We recommend that you carry a whistle

Safety bearing: If you get lost the safety bearing is North. When you reach the boundary fence that runs

along the dual carriageway, turn left and work your way along the edge of the area and back

to the event centre.

Road crossings: Please take care when crossing the minor road on your way to the start and back from the

finish

Water: There are some deep water features and these are marked as such on the map. A deep pond

by the start will be marked off with hazard warning tape. Parents should make

sure their children are aware of the risks.

Dogs: Dogs should be kept under control and on a lead when necessary.
