ORGANISER'S COMMENTS**Peter Bailey**

The November Classic is an important event in the orienteering calendar. Southampton Orienteering Club is fortunate in having access to one of the finest areas in the country - a fast, runnable mixture of heath and woodland which is at its best and most beautiful in mid-autumn, a time when our experience is that the weather seldom lets us down. This year was the thirtieth on which the Classic has taken place. I had the privilege of organising it.

Between eleven and twelve hundred runners took part. This year we faced, for the first time, the need to bus most of those participating on badge courses to the North Start. The system employed, a frequent service of small, warm vehicles running to a four or five minute headway worked well on a day which started extremely chill and misty.

I have to apologise to those using the South Start. I should have advised a longer time for walking in from the Assembly Area. Those who arrived minutes late were not penalised. Their slightly late starts have been allowed for in the results. I am concerned that the Forest authorities had men felling timber close to a control. This matter is being raised with them.

As a comparative newcomer to the sport this was my first attempt to organise an event. Inevitably I faced a steep learning curve but there were always colleagues willing to advise and help. My thanks go to all who assisted in whatever way, before, on and after the day. We left the Forest virtually as we found it. In two or three weeks it will be impossible to tell that we were there. That the litter collected at the Assembly Area, visited by over a thousand runners, failed to fill a modest carrier bag is indicative of the respect all orienteers have for the countryside they use. So my thanks go to all of you as well. I trust you enjoyed your runs and had as enjoyable a day as I did.

CONTROLLER'S COMMENTS**Richard Arman (WSX)**

Irons Well plus Fritham Plain and Bentley Enclosures is a huge area and being able to start the long courses from the North of the Irons Well map enabled Ian to produce good long courses going over open country into woodland, through open country again and finally back into the woods. The changes add difficulty and force runners to adjust their techniques, and add to that the fine point detail available in the open areas and you have the makings of good challenging courses.

We were pleased to finish the event with no vandalism of controls, no wrong placements and no errors in the paper back-up to the courses. The only problems were the fog, which must have mitigated against at least the first half of all the competitors, especially in the open areas, and the contractors decision to start thinning operations immediately alongside control 389 on the Saturday. The work continued on Sunday so a posted warning was really all that could be done.

Timings mostly fell into line with BOF recommendations but runners certainly felt that mistakes were often to prove very costly. I felt on reflection that some of the courses for the elderly athletes, particularly perhaps course 11, proved to be a little long and a bit too arduous; but then again the good came good and the not so good did less well - nothing changes! A dozen runners recorded times quicker than 6 minutes per kilometre, just amazing! We did have a lot of very favourable comment at the finish and most seemed to really enjoy the challenge - I stood for a long time at the finish in the sunshine and I still walk very well! How nice to have the backup strength of a club like SOC to ensure that all went so well on the day, even in the foggy early part of the day; well done SOC.
