FINAL DETAILS

- Location:** Car parking and event centre are at the Aegeas Bowl, SO30 3XJ.
As you enter the grounds, turn right into Car Park 1. Bear round to the left and drive to the end. This area of the car park is about 200m from the event centre.
- Timing:** Registration: 10:15 – 12:15
Start times: 10:30 – 12:30
Courses close: 14:00
- Entry:** Entry on the day only. EMIT timing system.
- Fees:** Adults £5, Juniors £2.
- Courses:** 60 minute odds and evens score counting towards the series league.
Easy course, 1.6km, for beginners and young children.
- Start:** Punching start (turn up and run). Start and Finish are both close to the event centre.
- Clothing:** Full leg cover must be worn. Whistles should be carried. In adverse weather we may ask you to wear a cagoule or similar waterproof top.
- Map:** Scale 1:4,000, updated 2016, minor corrections May 2018. Control descriptions on the map only.
- Safety:** The safety bearing is South. Courses close at 14:00 hrs.
Competitors attending the event alone **MUST** leave their car key at Registration.
All competitors must report to Download even if retiring from the event.
Orienteering is a physically challenging sport. Competitors take part at their own risk.

- Hazards:** The ponds in the northern area of the map are prone to flooding due to the ongoing car park development work at the Aegeas Bowl. A build up of earth is holding back the flow out of the ponds. If necessary the ponds and any flooding will be taped on the ground as OUT OF BOUNDS. Competitors must avoid this area and not cross any tapes. The wood is used by members of the public. Please be polite and considerate to other people in the area.
- Bio-security:** Please come to the event with clean and dry shoes and clothing. After your run please follow the guidance that helps protect our precious environment:
- Check
 - Clean
 - Dry
- Before leaving the event **check** your clothing and equipment and remove any mud, soil or leaf litter.
Once home thoroughly **clean** your footwear and clothing and then leave it to **dry** for as long as possible.
- Photography and O-Safe:** There are no official photographers for this event. Photography is not allowed in the toilets or any “changing area” including the car park. Any concerns with photography or the behaviour of anyone toward any child or young adult must be reported to the event organiser or other official.
- Dogs:** Dogs should be kept under control and on a lead when necessary.
- Risk assessment:** A comprehensive risk assessment has been carried out by the organiser and will be available to read at the event. Participants take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety during the event.
- Insurance:** The British Orienteering insurance policy provides public liability cover. Please note that if you have competed in three orienteering events and have not joined an orienteering club that is a member of British Orienteering, then you are not covered by this insurance.
