New area at The Gregg School, Townhill Park, Southampton. SO18 3RR

Location: Access from M27 Junction 5, then via A27 to Allington roundabout,

next to fuel station. Turn into Townhill Way, past Two Brothers pub, turn right into Atlantic Park view (signed Gregg School). Go through

tall iron gates into school site.

Sat Nav SO18 3RR. Park anywhere on hard standing. Best to bear right and turn onto tree avenue just past end of main building.

You will need a headlight to follow the markers to the cricket pavilion.

Terrain: School grounds, including formal gardens and woodland, playing fields

and a modern housing estate.

Course: 60 minute score with a twist! Pairs format. Explanation on the night.

Facilities: Assembly in heated cricket pavilion, so space limited. Bring your own

water. Toilets will be signed as they are in a separate building. Limited

First Aid.

Food: None at the event (space too small), but 2 local pubs do food. Two

Brothers on the estate, a bit basic, and the White Swan on the way back to the M27. The Car Park here floods frequently and is very wet

at the moment.

Times: Registration from 17.45 to 18.40

Starts from 18.00 to 18.45 Courses close 20.00

Entry: EOD but please fill in the <u>form</u> to reserve a map

Seniors £5 Juniors £3

Emit touch free punching. Lost tags charged at £45.

Safety: All competitors MUST where suitable hi-viz and have sufficient lighting

to complete their course. A back up light should be carried.

Those under 16 on the night must be accompanied by an adult.
