Royal Victoria Country Park

Location: The car parks and event centre are at Royal Victoria Country Park, Netley Abbey. Grid ref: SU463 079. Nearest postcode: SO31 5GA. Signposted from J8 M27 follow brown Tourist signs. Bus No 6 from Southampton to Netley Village then follow Brown tourist signs. Train to Netley Station then 5-10 minutes walk signposted from outside station car park.

Pay and Display parking 1 hour £1.80 All day £4.00.

Registration and limited parking are near the Chapel Tower.

Timing: Registration: 10:00 – 12:00
Start times: 10:30 – 12:30
Courses close: 14:00

Facilities: Cafe, gift shop, toilets, play area, miniature train, bbq sites. Park run (5km) at 9 am.

Entry: Entry on the day. EMIT (touch free) timing system. Turn up and run.

- Map:** Scale 1:5,000, 5m contours, updated 2016. Courses and control descriptions will be over printed on A4 waterproof paper. No loose control descriptions
- Terrain:** Country park. A mixture of open lawn, meadow grass, woodland paths and undergrowth. Some steep slopes and steps which can be slippery. Courses cross a boardwalk which can be wobbly and slippery. Please take care.
- Start:** Start and finish are in the car park near the Chapel tower.
- Clothing:** Full leg cover recommended as courses may go through long grass or undergrowth. Steep slippery paths and steps so wear shoes with good grip.
- Safety bearing:** If you get lost follow direction boards around the park to the Cedar Café.
- Hazards:** Do not attempt to cross the train track. It would be very embarrassing to be hit by the miniature train! All courses cross the park roads. There is a low speed limit. Please take care and be considerate of other park users.
- Dogs:** Dogs should be kept under control and on a lead when necessary.
